

I disagree with a lot of the actions he recommends, but I found it interesting that his take on the middle class in 1971 is how the middle class views its role in 2015. Prior to hearing about Alinsky a couple of years ago, I knew very little about him. When I bought this book I wasn't looking for a guide to change society but rather to get a perspective on how a radical thinks. There are a lot of similarities in his thoughts and actions and the thoughts and actions of some politicians today. It reads like a textbook and is pretty dry.
